Resuscitation Congress by the Danish Resuscitation Council



The Danish Resuscitation Council hosted its Congress on January 29, 2026, in Copenhagen, with 300 participants in attendance.

The main theme for the Congress was “Policy and Evidence in Resuscitation”, focusing on how health policy, research evidence, and clinical practice intersect in the field of resuscitation.

The conference brought together healthcare professionals, researchers, policymakers, and emergency responders to share the latest scientific findings and debate current challenges in resuscitation science and practice.

Highlights of the event included keynote speeches from government ministers, a panel discussion with health spokespersons, a demonstration of resuscitation techniques by an EMS team, and presentations on the latest research.
